RENEWAL

RENEWAL YEARLY, ONLINE OR BY MAIL. YOU MAY CHOOSE ANY START DATE, BUT IT IS HELPFUL TO RENEW IN AUGUST WHEN SCHOOL STARTS, SO DON'T FORGET!



RENEWAL YEARLY. UPON RENEWAL YOU WILL SUBMIT DOCUMENTATION IN EITHER:
1. PORTFOLIO - 2 SAMPLES EACH ELA, MATH, SCI, SS
2. LETTER FROM TEACHER CERTIFIED TO TEACH THAT LEVEL
3. TEST RESULTS (YOUR CHOICE)

How you choose to register is up to you. Do note that to qualify for TOPS students may need to be registered for Home Study for at least the LAST TWO years of school (11th and 12 grades).

There are online and virtual type of schooling but legally in LA, programs such as K12 and Connections are NOT considered homeschooling and you would not register either of these ways.

It is the responsibility of the PARENT to check the requirements of all scholarships, secondary education establishments, employers and so on regarding your homeschooled student.
